



Dallas Fort Worth International Airport Board Driver Permitting Requirements

- ✓ All driver applicants shall be at least 19 years of age and shall provide the following documents in order to apply of a DFW Airport drivers permit.
- ✓ Certificate of Completion for each company(s) driver training program that meets the requirements set forth in the Chapter 4, Section 4-2 III Code of the Rules and Regulations of the Dallas / Fort Worth International Airport Board.
- ✓ A driver permit application signed and dated within the thirty (30) days proceeding the date of the application by an authorized representative of the company. For limousines, the authorized signature of the drivers permit application must be notarized
- ✓ Application fee in accordance with the Dallas / Fort Worth International Airport Board Schedule of Charges, as amended. Current charges:
 - Renewal Permits (\$30.00)
 - New Permits (\$50.00)
- ✓ Valid Texas drivers license
- ✓ Proof of legal residency or currently authorized to work full-time in the United States.
(Note: List of Acceptable documents listed on the back of this document)
- ✓ Defensive Driving Certificate
 - Applicants shall provide an original Texas Education Agency approved defensive driving certificate that is dated within the twelve (12) months preceding the date of the application. A receipt from an approved defensive driving course will be accepted as proof that the defensive driving course was taken, however the original certificate must be submitted before a two (2) year permit is issued.
- ✓ Taxicab driver permit applicants shall also provide:
 - A completed and signed contract from each company to be listed on the drivers permit.
 - New driver permit applicants shall provide a driver permit from another city as proof of six (6) months experience.
- ✓ Limousine driver permit applicants shall be bona fide employees of the holder of operating authority.
Note: Independent contractors are not permitted.
