The BOARD reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities, to advertise for new bids, or proceed to do the work by other means when in the best interests of the BOARD. No Bidder may withdraw its Bid within sixty (60) calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

It is the policy of the BOARD to increase M/WBE (DBE) involvement to the maximum extent feasible. In furtherance of this policy, the BOARD has implemented the M/WBE (DBE) Program. The successful contractor will be required to demonstrate, through a written narrative, their efforts to involve and utilize M/WBE's (DBE) at the recommended goal level of 32%.

Possible subcontracting areas include, but are not limited to, the following: plumbing, carpentry, mechanical, and electrical.

BID SECURITY in the amount of five percent (5%) of bid amount must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
