The Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport Board (DFW) intends to select a consultant to provide Design and Design Management Services for the DFW Airport Development & Engineering Department Team (ADT) to supplement Airport Staff and to provide services as required. The projects will be located at the Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport.

You are hereby invited to submit ten (10) copies of your organization's Qualifications. The qualifications and other information should be submitted on a Standard Form (SF) 330 and in strict compliance with the directives provided in the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) documents. The RFQ will be available for pickup from the DFW Airport Development and Engineering Department, located at 3003 South Service Road, after 11:00 AM, "Local Time", on October 06, 2009. Contact Cathleen Baulisch at 972-973-1716 to have the RFQ documents mailed or sent via overnight delivery service to your firm at Consultant's cost.

A PRE-QUALIFICATION CONFERENCE will be held at 10:00 AM, "Local Time", Wednesday, October 14, 2009, at the ADE Building, located at 3003 South Service Road, Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport, Texas.

The STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS documents (your organization's Qualifications) are due to 3003 South Service Road, by 12:00 Noon, "Local Time", on October 27, 2009. NO LATE SUBMITTALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

The Qualifications will be reviewed for conformance to the Preparation Instructions outlined in this RFQ. A short list of the highest ranked firms is anticipated by October 30, 2009. After the short list is established, the Selection Committee may conduct formal interviews with the short-listed firms. A selection of the most qualified firm is anticipated by November 16, 2009.

The selected firm will be requested to submit a pricing proposal shortly after selection. If an agreement cannot be reached between DFW and the selected firm, the next ranked firm will be requested to submit a pricing proposal.

It is the policy of the Board to increase D/M/WBE involvement to the maximum extent feasible. In furtherance of this policy, the Board has implemented the D/M/WBE Program. The successful consultant will be required to demonstrate, through a written narrative, its efforts to involve and utilize D/M/WBE's at the recommended goal levels. This project has a goal of twenty percent (20%) of the total dollar value of the Base Contract, including any Change Orders, and thirty-five percent (35%) of the total dollar value of all Supplemental Agreements, including any Change Orders.

Funding for this Contract may be Federally assisted. Contractor must comply with all applicable federal requirements including: Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title VI – Contractor Contractual Requirements; Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982, Section 520 – Title 49 U.S.C. 47123 – General Civil Rights Provisions; Disadvantaged Business Enterprises; Lobbying and Influencing Federal Employees; Access to Records and Reports; Breach of Contract Terms; Rights to Inventions; Termination of Contract; Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion; and Clean Air and Water Pollution Control.
