DFW Airport offers new covered parking for Terminal B passengers

New parking option offers reduced-rate parking while protecting vehicles from summer rays

DALLAS/FORT WORTH AIRPORT, TEXAS (July 25, 2001) – Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport gives Terminal B passengers another option to protect their vehicle from summer's rays and the rainy season with the opening of new covered infield parking at Remote Parking for Terminal B on Friday, July 27. An additional 1,070 parking spaces are available with covered protection at only \$9 per day.

“We're upgrading parking options at DFW Airport for our guests, and infield covered parking at a reduced rate is the next best option to garage parking at the terminals,” said Byford Treanor, Vice president of Customer Service.

The material used for the covered parking canopies is a high-density polyethylene fabric, which will provide 88 percent shade, block up to 91 percent of the sun's ultra-violet rays and provide 85 percent coverage from heavy rains, permitting only a mist of rain on vehicles.

Remote Parking for Terminal B is located just minutes north of Terminal B. From International Parkway, follow Terminal B Remote signs. Quick and easy access to Terminal B is provided by shuttle service, with passenger pick-up and drop-off points within the lot.

Remote Parking for Terminal B provides a value parking option for people flying the following Airlines: America West, American Trans Air, British Airways, Continental, Frontier, Japan Air Lines, Korean Air, Lufthansa, Mesa, Midwest Express, National, Sun Country, TWA, United, USAir and Vanguard. American Airlines passengers are strongly encouraged to use Value AA parking instead of Remote Parking for Terminal B, because of

the distinct possibility of departing from Terminal B but arriving back into a different terminal.

Located halfway between the cities of Dallas and Fort Worth, Texas, DFW International Airport is the world's third busiest, serving 60 million passengers a year. Offering nearly 2,300 flights daily, DFW Airport provides nonstop service to 132 domestic and 32 international destinations worldwide.
