The Airport recorded an estimated 1.125 million passengers during the period June 23 to 29, making this the second week in a row for a million-plus travelers through DFW. And the Airport forecasts 1.79 million holiday passengers will travel through DFW June 27 - July 7, a 2.3 percent increase over the same period last year.

"All of the travel numbers are giving us positive indicators for a strong summer travel season," says Joe Lopano, executive vice president of marketing and revenue management at DFW. "The Iraq war and SARS scare are gone, and there's pent-up demand for business and leisure travel. Our major carriers also are seeing fuller planes and that's a good sign for DFW."

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In addition, travelers to DFW will also experience some of the fastest security lines in the country and rapid access to the Airport's 30,000 parking spaces. "We're ready to help, we're accessible, we're easy to navigate," says Lopano. "Our priority of keeping security high and travel hassles low is in effect every day at DFW and will be even more apparent during the holiday season."
