Prior to joining Texas Instruments, he served on the staff of the Texas Senate Jurisprudence Committee and as an attorney with Sun Exploration and Production Company in Dallas.

Phil's community involvement is extensive. He recently served as Chairman of the Board for the United Way of Metropolitan Dallas, is a member of the Board of Governors of the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, and a trustee of the Dallas Foundation. He previously served as a Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Board of Directors, which included a period of service on the Regional Transportation Council of the North Central Texas Council of Governments.

Phil earned an undergraduate degree in Urban Studies and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Maryland, and a Master of Public Affairs from the LBJ School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas at Austin. He is admitted to the practice of law in Maryland and Texas.
