CLARIFICATIONS 1

Re: Solicitation No. 8005396

Please be advised of the following clarifications to the above referenced Solicitation.

Q1. I read SECTION 10.4 that it would be possible for us to bid just the air monitoring portion of this contract is this correct?

A1. DFW will not be issuing multiples awards and is not interested in only air monitoring services only.

Q2. How do I register as a HUB and Minority owner company with DFW?

A2. The DFW Airport does not certify companies. In order to count the participation of a Minority-Women Business Enterprise (M/WBEs) towards the Contract Specific Goal, the M/WBE must be certified by the North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency (NCTRCA), DFW Minority Supplier Development Council or the Women's Business Council Southwest. Other certifications are not acceptable. In addition to having a valid certification from one of the entities listed above, the M/WBE must have a physical place of business in the Airport Board's relevant market area at the time the bid or proposal is submitted for credit towards meeting the M/WBE goal. The Airport Board's relevant market area is Dallas, Tarrant, Collin and Denton counties.

Q3. A WMBE we wish to subcontract to has a pending certification with NCTRCA. The NCTRCA is saying they are operating on Covid-19 skeleton staff. We submitted in October. And there is a status page, it is still showing submitted, pending receipt. Can we list as a potential sub once they are certified?

A3. Unfortunately, they would not count toward the goal. Minority-Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) must be certified by the North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency (NCTRCA), DFW Minority Supplier Development Council or the Women's Business Council Southwest in order to count toward the goal. Other certifications are not acceptable. In addition to having a valid certification from one of the entities listed above, the M/WBE must have a physical place of business in the Airport Board's relevant market area at the time the bid or proposal is submitted for credit towards meeting the M/WBE goal. The Airport Board's relevant market area is Dallas, Tarrant, Collin and Denton counties.

Q4. On RFP No. 8005396, we are considering teaming as a sub with another company. We have submitted our application to the North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency (NCTRCA) months ago. Because of Covid-19, they are operating with a skeleton crew, and applications are taking longer to process. And there is a status page, it is still showing submitted, pending receipt.
